About Birmingham-Southern College

Founded in 1856, Birmingham-Southern College is a residential, baccalaureate liberal arts college with just over 1,200 students and a student/faculty ratio of 13:1. BSC is the only nationally ranked liberal arts college in Alabama, one of only three Phi Beta Kappa sheltering institutions in Alabama, and the only Alabama institution listed among "Colleges that Change Lives." BSC has been named in the Fiske Guide to Colleges 2021, The Princeton Review's 2021 Best Regional Colleges List, and as one of the top National Liberal Arts Colleges by U.S. News & World Report in "Best Colleges" for 2021.

Through highly personalized teaching and mentorship, BSC prepares students for careers that relate directly to their majors and for detours that lead to fulfilling work on less obvious pathways. Birmingham-Southern College has approximately 50,000 solicitable records, including just over 16,000 solicitable alumni. Solicitable segments include alumni, current and former parents, current and former faculty and staff, and friends of the College. BSC's annual giving programs include:

- Crowdfunding (Giving Tuesday, day of giving, etc.)
- Online outreach
- Direct mail
- Phonathon
- Student philanthropy
- Matching giving
- Text-to-give initiatives
- Leadership annual giving

These programs generate both donor-restricted and unrestricted revenue. We define annual giving as any support under \$25,000; therefore the "price tags" associated with this project reflect a variety of opportunities that fall within that range.

Registry Project Background Information

In Fall 2019, Birmingham-Southern College piloted a new "Funding Opportunities" initiative that compiled fundable projects within academic departments and strategic campus areas into a centralized "registry" of giving opportunities. Our objective was twofold. First, we aimed to demonstrate to donors the tangible impact of their annual gifts. To accomplish this, we identified budget-relieving and budget-additive fundable projects, with the goal of publishing these items in order to allow donors to browse the descriptions and costs themselves.

In doing this, we aimed to encourage increased giving by demonstrating the power of what larger gifts could accomplish. Our primary target for this project was leadership-level annual giving donors, which we define as any donor giving between \$5,000 and \$24,999 in a single fiscal year.

For internal purposes, we define budget-relieving items as any gift supplementing annual operational costs, while budget-additive items provide funding for projects above and beyond those budgeted for during the current fiscal year. For the purposes of this project, we expanded our definition of leadership annual giving to include opportunities between \$500 and \$25,000.

We designed this initiative as a direct response to the growing industry trend away from "unrestricted" giving, allowing BSC to address our donors' desire for specificity and accountability. Our vision was that by packaging these projects in an experience that mimicked the ease of modern online shopping, donors would feel informed and empowered, selecting projects that spoke to their individual interests and passions.

By partnering with academic department chairs and campus leaders, we were able to compile a list of funding opportunities that were both relevant to specific departments and interesting to our donors. As items were "purchased" by a donor, we notified each department and provided stewardship direction. Faculty members were grateful for the opportunity to thank donors who impacted their department, and donors expressed to us their appreciation for the personalized stewardship they received.

We began communicating with pre-identified donors in September 2019 through a series of targeted and segmented emails (samples below). The initial communications had a "Back to School Shopping" theme that was fitting for the time of year, and allowed us to succinctly explain the concept of the campaign within a pre-existing framework.

This approach caught the attention of our constituents and enabled gift officers to initiate follow-up conversations both with loyal and lapsed donors, facilitating thoughtful and transparent discussions about the projects each donor found motivating and impactful.

We sent additional emails about the registry over the holidays. Gift officers then continued to work oneon-one with potential donors throughout Spring 2020. During these conversations, some donors chose to continue their support of the Forward Ever Fund (Annual Fund), although many expressed appreciations at being given the opportunity for greater specificity.

Please note that everything submitted is not on the published list, at least not in its first iteration. Once we see what donors respond to, we'll help Santa make a holiday shopping list and promote that as part of our year-end giving effort. Thanks to your help, we now also have a more robust list of projects and opportunities to discuss with donors in one-on-one meetings, especially those at higher dollar levels. If you have fresh ideas for what might go on the rebooted list, let us know.

Communication about these giving opportunities will be targeted toward selected donors who are already giving at the leadership level, as well as those whose loyal support indicates they may be ready to increase their giving. Even though not everyone will receive the email, since you are in touch with many former students and others who love BSC, we wanted you to know the plan and be a part of this effort.

Water bottle filling stations encourage the use of reusable water bottles instead of plastic water bottles, which take over 1,000 years to biodegrade in a landfill.

The filling stations keep a count of how many plastic water bottles are being saved through every use – showing students the positive impact they are making on the environment.

Outcomes

We solicited 1,162 prospects as a part of this campaign throughout FY20. Together, those donors contributed \$862,965 both to the registry and to other funds. We also saw increased gifts, which has renewed our focus on targeted moves-management with our donor base.

As a result of COVID-19, our funding priorities have shifted slightly for FY21, and the registry campaign has become less of a focal point. We are now using the registry as a talking point for one-to-one communications with leadership-level donors but decided not to move forward with a comprehensive communications plan for FY21.

Our plan is to shift focus back to the registry for FY22. This will allow time for gift officers to review new funding opportunities, especially those that have come to light as a result of the pandemic. Our updated registry will have an increased focus on classroom technology, which will allow us to expand upon the "new normal" of providing additional online resources for students.
