The COVID-19 pandemic has created many challenges for Viterbo students. Here is one example:

“Jake” is a full-time nursing student who balances schoolwork, part-time employment, and personal challenges. Under normal circumstances life can be difficult enough. “Jake” had transferred to Viterbo University to experience first-hand the close community and exceptional faculty and staff service. Then, in early March, when the threat of COVID-19 struck the area, “Jake” lost both of his part-time jobs in health care. He went from working 16 hours a week to 0 hours. His loss of work created uncertainty around looming rent payments and challenges with purchasing groceries. “Jake,” like many college students, does not benefit from food, unemployment, and other social assistance programs.
