When COVID-19 became a part of our lives in spring 2020, the university was put to the test. We made hard decisions, and most students returned home to continue their studies online. The pandemic not only disrupted the lives of Temple students on an academic level but a personal one as well.

Students like Kylie had their hours reduced or lost their jobs altogether in the space of weeks, creating a situation where some could no longer provide for basic needs like groceries, medication and reliable internet access.
