the addition of a health center in the lower level of Memorial Chapel, and necessary investments in campus safety, housekeeping and technology, Sweet Briar has incurred costs and lost revenue totaling at least \$3 million. These needs are in addition to the budgeted Sweet Briar Fund goal of \$5 million and restricted needs totaling \$500,000.

That's why this year, even more than previous years, Sweet Briar needs you! According to our records, 92.7 percent of your class has yet to make a gift to Sweet Briar this year. Please join us in making your gift during March Days of Giving this year, March 1-10, 2021. The College has three goals at this time: raising \$500,000 on March 1, raising another \$500,000 from March 2 through 10, and reaching 20% participation by the end of March.
