# How Do I Ask My Classmates to Participate in the Class Gift?

Leading by example is the simplest way to ask classmates to participate in the Class Gift. As a Reunion Committee member, when you ask your classmates to join you by making a gift to support the school, you will help us increase alumni participation as well as keep alumni connected and engaged.

### What Does My Gift Support?

  - Career services and networking opportunities for current and former students

### Tips for Making the Phone Call

- Lead by example by making your own gift or multi-year pledge to your Reunion Class Gift!
- Review the contact information provided to you for the classmate you are calling.
- Begin by introducing yourself as a member of the Reunion Committee.
- To break the ice, ask what they have been up to since you last spoke, and when they've been back to campus recently.

- Ask if they plan to attend Reunion Weekend June 11-13, 2021.
- Share current information about Fairfield, and be sure to share your own reasons for supporting the University. The goal is to get the entire class to participate!
- Fairfield University also accepts gifts online through Venmo @Fairfield-UniversityGiveAGift.
- If they want to make a gift or pledge advise them to visit fairfield.edu/ give or call our office toll-free at 1-877-748-5123. If you take a pledge please let us know.
- Take a moment to verify their contact information and ask them to join the Class Facebook group.
- Email or call your Reunion Class Staff Manager with any news you discover, such as a new job, move to a new city, married, had a child.

- I also hope you will join me in making a gift to Stags for Stags to commemorate our Reunion and help today's students.
- Do you know about our tradition of making a Reunion Class Gift?
  Our goal is to have as many classmates as possible participate in the Class Gift.

#### If the answer is no ...

If the answer is "no" or if the individual is reluctant to give, encourage participation at whatever level is comfortable for him or her.

- Every gift, regardless of size, makes a difference to Fairfield.
- No matter what the outcome, be sure to thank the individuals for their time and thoughtful consideration of your request.
- The key is that gifts at all levels are needed and appreciated. It is better to have participation at some level than no participation at all.
