During our reunion year celebration, we are also kicking off a giving participation challenge! As part of completing the <u>McGregor Computer Science Center</u> this spring, Harvey Mudd is also opening the **makerspace**, a facility filled with tools and working space for students to use for creative projects and prototyping!

We're excited to be sponsoring the addition of a <u>Jacquard loom</u> in the makerspace and supporting a **Makerspace Summer Steward grant** for students working in the makerspace between school years.

The TC2 jacquard loom enables the user to visualize, materialize, explore, experiment and discover. It is used by freelance designers and independent artists who create customized or one-off pieces for art installations, functional textiles and fashion. Jacquard looms are used to research hypoallergenic textiles and uniforms and sportswear with built-in smart functionalities. In learning more about the makerspace, the reunion committee fell in love with the loom as a gift that combined technology and art, providing students with a unique device for making their designs a reality. This gift will honor both the Class of 1996 as a whole and the memory of the classmates and faculty who are no longer with us.

To fund both goals, our class needs to raise at least \$75,000 as a five-year giving pledge. Due to the generous support of our classmates, we have already secured \$35,000 in challenge gifts, with the goal of increasing the participation of the entire class.


