

The Future Scholarship – A Lasting Tribute

Lamont O. Repollet, Ed.D. was selected as the 18th leader of Kean University by unanimous vote of the Kean University Board of Trustees on May 11, 2020, following a comprehensive national search. He assumed the presidency on July 1, 2020, succeeding Dawood Farahi, Ph.D. who had served in the role since 2003.

A Kean alumnus and former member of the Board of Trustees, Repollet is a thoughtful and charismatic educator. In his first few months as our new leader, he has already put Kean on the road to boldly expand its commitment to safety, academic excellence, and equity.
